

# Estimated Impact of Triggered Pupil Transportation Cuts on Local Education Agencies

This report contains an estimate of the amount of pupil transportation funding each Local Education Agency (LEA) would lose if the budget trigger is pulled. While these estimates are based on data from the California Department of Education, they are not “official,” and the final numbers may vary somewhat. However, these numbers will be very close to the actual cuts and can be used for local planning purposes.

## Background

The 2011-12 state budget contains a “trigger” that will automatically reduce funding for specified programs if state revenues fall short of budget estimates, as determined by the Legislative Analyst and the Director of Finance. If revenues fall between \$1 billion and \$2 billion short of estimates, then about \$600 million of “Tier 1” cuts will be triggered. These cuts will affect higher education, health and welfare, and public safety programs.

If revenues fall more than \$2 billion short of estimates, then “Tier 2” cuts will be triggered. The first item in Tier 2 is \$248 million for pupil transportation. The next item is a reduction to revenue limits of up to 4 percent.

Because funding for transportation is extremely inequitable, cutting transportation funding will also have an extremely inequitable impact on LEAs. Some LEAs do not receive any transportation funding from the state, so they would be unaffected. For others, state funding for transportation represents a significant portion of their total budgets, and they will be heavily affected. Charter schools will be unaffected, even though transportation funding is built into their block grants.

## How to Read the Table

LEAs are listed by district code within each county. Simply go to your county and scroll down to find your district. The first column of dollar amounts shows the total estimated transportation apportionment for each district in 2011-12. The last column shows the amount that would be reduced if the trigger is pulled.

## What You Can Do

Share this information with your colleagues, parents, and others in your community. Discuss the impact on your districts (and on them) if these cuts are realized. Will transportation services be eliminated? Will students have to walk further distances to school? Generate local community support for taking these cuts off the trigger list, and meet with your representatives in the State Assembly and Senate. Ask them to commit to taking funding for school transportation off the cut list.
